

**Terms of Participation Incoming TRADE MISSION
10-15 OCTOBER 2010**

1. Application

- 1.1 The company or institution should have a Permanent Account Number (PAN).
- 1.2 The application form must be filled in completely.
- 1.3 The application will be accepted after the company or institution has received a confirmation from ME-INDIA. Only ME-INDIA can provide further information about the project.
- 1.4 ME-INDIA reserves the right to cancel applications if the required information is not received in due time for the proper conduct of the organization, this may include, e.g. incomplete intake forms.
- 1.5 ME-INDIA reserves the right to maximize the number of participants per enterprise to two participants.
- 1.6 The company or institution takes part in the trade mission and agrees to arrange their transportation or flight to the Netherlands on their own account. ME-India shall arrange transport from and to the airport as well as transport during the official programme.
- 1.7 Participants take part in the trade mission at their own risk. ME-INDIA is in no event liable for damages that may arise for participants before, during or after participation in the trade mission, unless ME-INDIA can be assigned blame for deliberate or gross negligence for the cause of damages.

2. Selection of participants

- 2.1 By the coordinator(s) of ME-INDIA, and when they think necessary the decision may also be made in concert with the programme management of the EVD, the participants are being selected from the applications for the ME-INDIA programme.
- 2.2 ME-INDIA treats applications in order of entry, in which ME-INDIA reserves the right to refuse applications if ME-INDIA finds substantial grounds to do so on her own judgement. Taken into consideration are, among other things, the goals of the company or institution, the character of the mission, and a balanced composition of the applicants.
- 2.3 Correspondence on the selection is not possible and ME-INDIA does not fulfil any responsibility in this matter.

3. Participation

- 3.1 Within her programme ME-INDIA has space to cover the costs of a maximum of 15 participants of the trade mission.
- 3.2 The costs conducted by ME-INDIA relate to
 - a. The hotel nights during the period of the mission including breakfast.
 - b. The transport from and to the airport on 10th and 15th October respectively.
 - c. The meals that are part of the programme excluding drinks.
- 3.3 All costs not mentioned in 3.2 are for the account of the participant of the trade mission.
- 3.4 Participation will be confirmed after the flight information is provided by the participant, including a copy of the ticket, within 7 days after acceptance of participation to ME-INDIA. Until this period participation is not final and, in case of the documents not being submitted, another participant can be selected
- 3.5 When proposed privileges or instruments as offered in 3.2 by ME-INDIA are not honoured owing to the conduct of others or by force of nature, then ME-INDIA cannot be held liable in any way.
- 3.6 Every day during the trade mission ME-INDIA will provide a contact point for the participants for questions and other issues.

4. Travel and stay

- 4.1 ME-India does not provide for VISA, (travel)insurances or other personal taxes and fees.
- 4.2 Selected participants are communicated to the Dutch Consulate of Mumbai, on this basis the participant can arrange his or her VISA

5. Cancellation

- 5.1 If you decide not to participate after acceptance, you must notify ME-INDIA as soon as possible so that your place can be made available for other interested parties.

By ME-INDIA it is meant in these terms of participation the executor of this activity, known as Incoming Trade Mission on behalf of ME-INDIA. For the Incoming Trade Mission the executor Bharat Entertainment International B.V. is situated at Kiotoweg 701, 3047 BG, Rotterdam
